Tamal Das, PhD, Assistant Professor and Head, Department of Physiology, Vidyasagar Metropolitan College, University of Calcutta, India. He was previously a researcher in a WHO international project. He has 22 international publications. His research interests are on occupational health, physical ergonomics and design. He is the life member of different learned societies including Indian Society of Ergonomics.

He has more than 110 publications in different national and international journals. Presently he serves as the Vice President of the Indian Society of Ergonomics.



Sougata Karmakar, PhD, Professor in the Department of Design, Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Guwahati, India. He teaches Ergonomics/Human Factors at the undergraduate (B.Des), post-graduate (M.Des) and doctoral levels. His research interests include Physical Ergonomics, Cognitive Ergonomics, Occupational Health & Safety, User-centered and Universal Design. He has published 53 research papers in international journals. He has acquired a good number of patents and design registrations for his innovative designs. He is an EC member of the Indian Society of Ergonomics.
