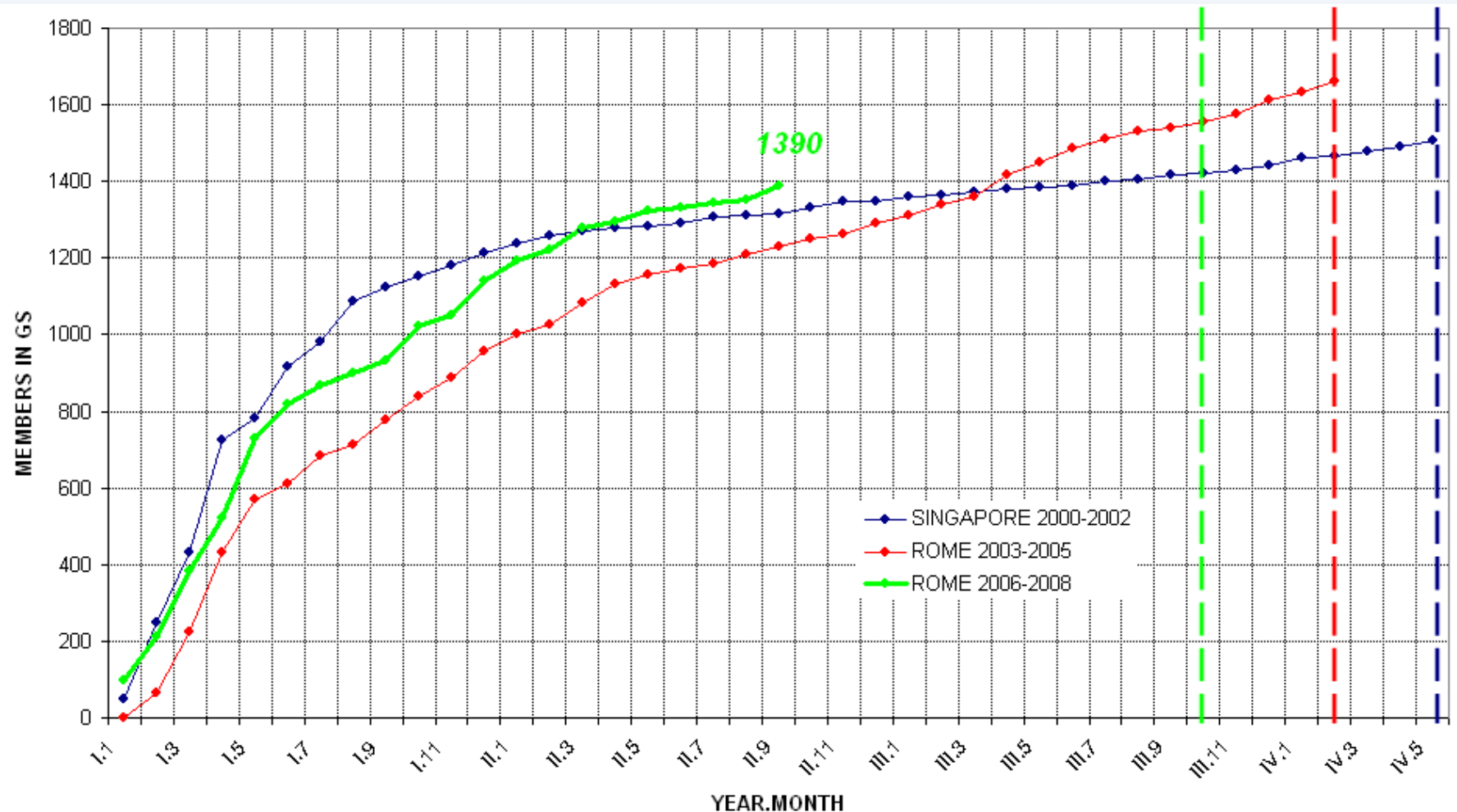

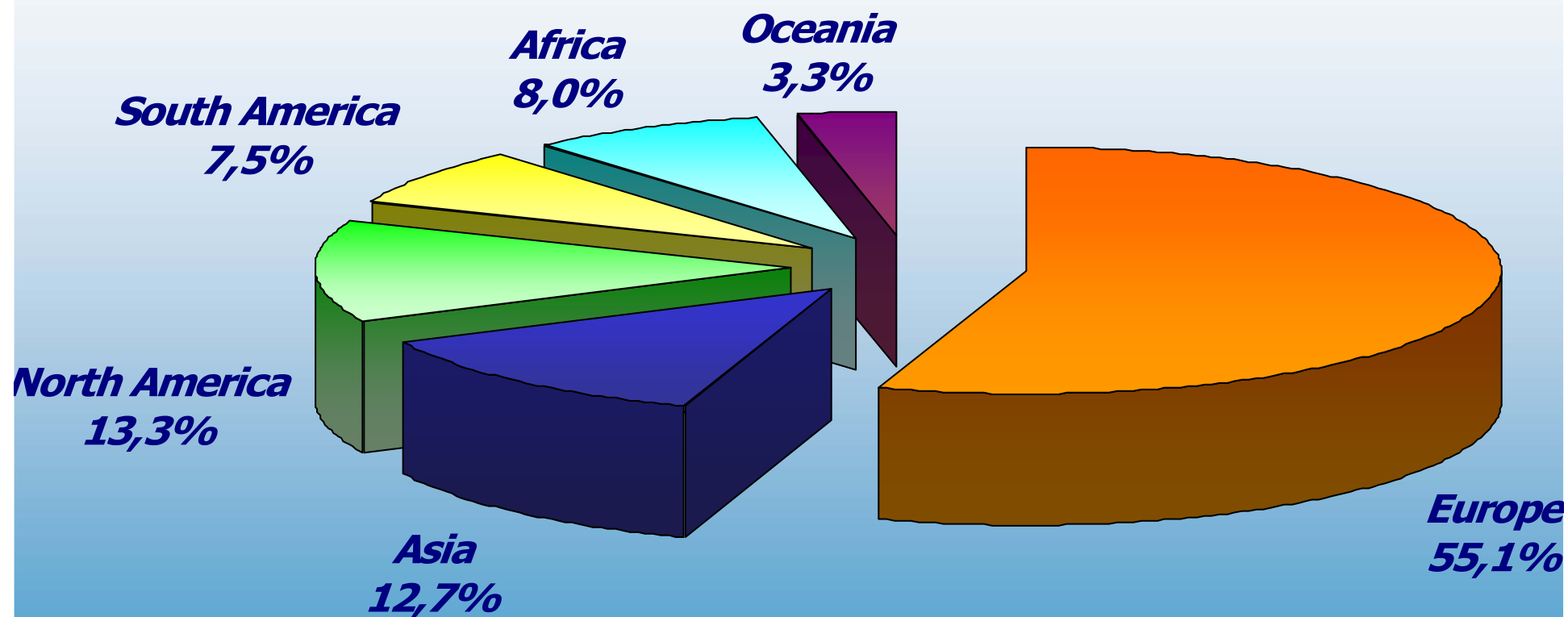

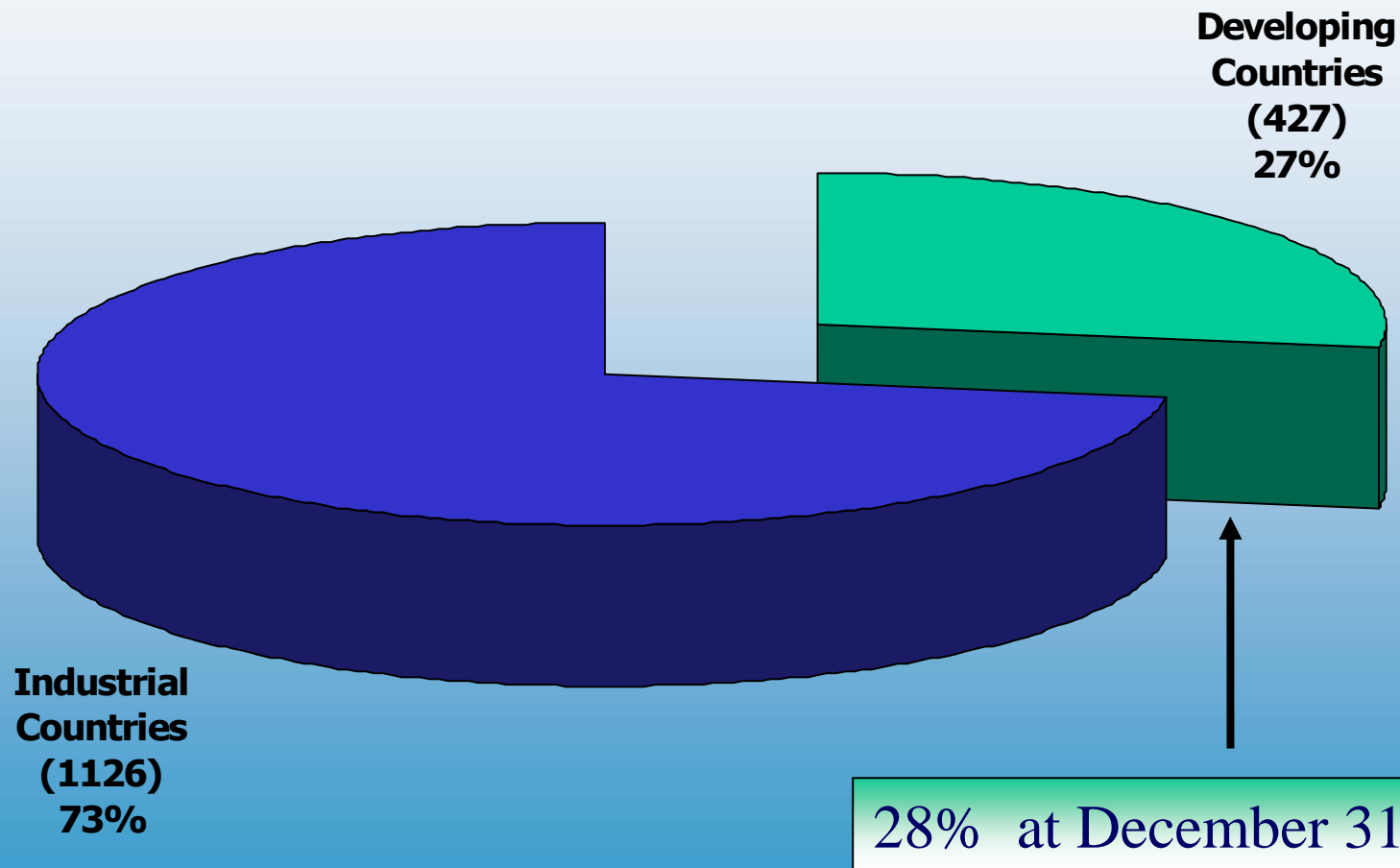
ICOH members geographical distribution*

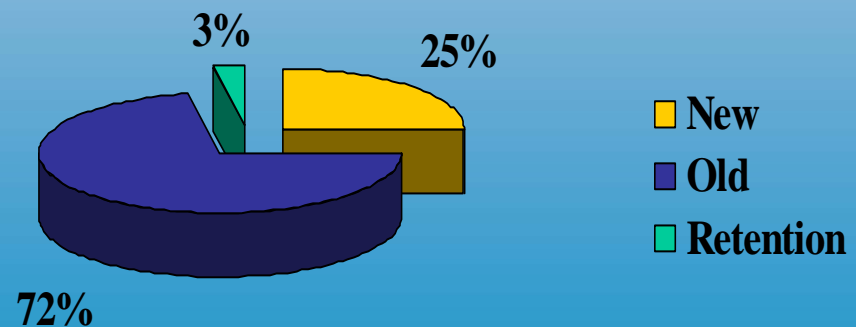
